How do analysts and other stakeholders use JODI data

Data Feeds

- Utilize JODI Data sets (Production, Crude Runs, Inventories etc.)
- Standardized Data format

Facilitates creation of Global/Regional Supply/Demand Balances

Forecasting import/export and inventories several months out

 S&D analytics are used to drive trading and commercial activity decisions

How do analysts benefit from JODI

Encourages countries to improve their energy statistics

- Improved the frequency, reliability and completeness of the data
- Data transparency has been improved greatly since JODI started

Complements existing data sources

• JODI doesn't replace individual energy agencies, but complements them by housing the data together

Improves data quality and format

- Standardized csv files allow users to retrieve data without any hassles
 - Major data vendors are adding this functionality to their datasets, making them even easier to retrieve

Why is JODI important to analysts


Database is comprehensive and covers all products

Coverage of Non-OECD Demand

- Non-OECD Demand surpassed OECD Demand in 2014
- JODI Database provides analysts with regular data on LatAm, Asia and Africa

Inventory Data	 Separation between SPR/Commercial inventories
Trade flow statistics	 Imports broken by country of source Exports broken by country of destination
Enhance Coverage	 More comprehensive data on Africa and Central Asia
