## 7th IEF Meeting in Riyadh 2000


- OPEC as one of the participating organizations

## Launching of Joint Oil Data Exercise (JODE)


- Designing the original oil data questionnaire a challenge









## JODI oil data generally at good quality but...






### there are still challenges ahead






## Setting priorities is key for improvement

## Similar challenges to oil during early times




Priorities similar to those for oil towards improvements






### Increasing interaction of energy commodities




- Natural gas & oil
  - Primary side (NGLs)
  - Secondary side (all products, specifically the lighter, LPG, naphtha, NGLs)
  - Petrochemical industry
- Renewables & oil
  - Commingled with petroleum products
- Coal & oil
  - Feedstocks & oxygenates
- Oil, coal & gas with electricity generation



#### Ideas for future focus



- Natural gas & oil:
  - Well established JODI initiatives
  - Monthly detailed data available
- Natural gas & oil lacking transparency without data from other energy commodities
  - Transformation
  - Substitution
- Coal: Need for more granular data identified
  - Work already established within JODI
- Other energy commodities: Similarly important



#### The role of JODI



- JODI could contribute substantially
  - Strengthening global producer-consumer cooperation and dialogue
  - Well-established
  - All major stakeholders participating
  - Extensive experience & know-how thru oil & gas initiatives

 JODI as an essential tool for improving overall transparency in the energy markets
