Joint Organisations Data Initiative

3rd Gas Data Transparency Conference, 4-5 June 2013, Bali, Indonesia

Calls for the extension of JODI to gas date back to 2006

2006

Ministers called for the extension of JODI to other fuels at the IEF10 in Doha, Qatar

2009

Calls for JODI Gas at the G8 Summit in L'Aquila and at the G20 Summit in Pittsburgh; JODI-Gas exercise launched.

2011

JODI-Gas supported at the G20 Summit in Cannes.

2013

Public launch of JODI-Gas scheduled during the second half of the year



2008

Ministers called for the extension of JODI to natural gas at the IEF11, and at the Extraordinary Energy Ministerial Meetings of Jeddah and London

2010

JODI-Gas supported by Ministers at the IEF12 in Mexico

2012

Strong support for JODI-Gas shown by Ministers at the IEF13 in Kuwait; in October, JODI-Gas became a permanent reporting initiative

2014

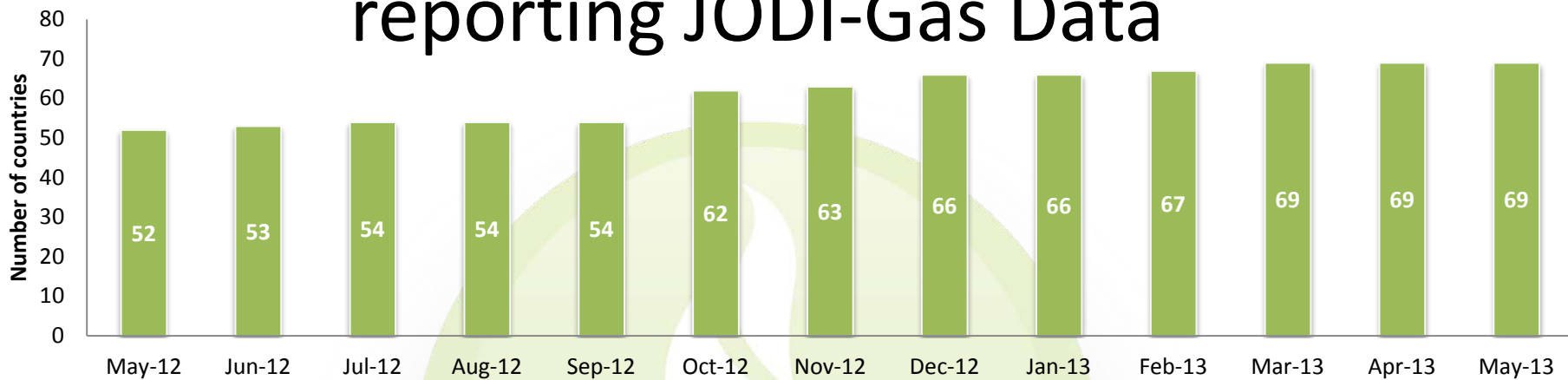
The IEF and JODI Partners will receive on-going feedback, and will make adjustments and improvements to the platform as necessary

Month by month record of countries reporting JODI-Gas Data



IEF Held the Second Gas Data Transparency Conference in Doha with 52 countries submitting monthly JODI-Gas data representing 2/3 of global natural gas supply and demand.

OPEC Economic Board approved that OPEC countries to start collecting JODI-Gas monthly data and participate in JODI-Gas.

JODI-Gas became a permanent initiative.

IEA Governing Board approved to institutionalise JODI-Gas monthly data as a requirement by IEA countries.

IEA Impact of the Governing Board. More countries from **UNSD** and **OLADE**. This raised the number of countries participating in JODI-Gas to 66 countries representing 70% of global natural gas supply and 80% of global natural gas demand.

Launched Beta version of the JODI-Gas Data base

Bahrain started submitting JODI-Gas data raising countries participating in JODI-Gas to 67.

Held workshop with 22 **OLADE** countries.

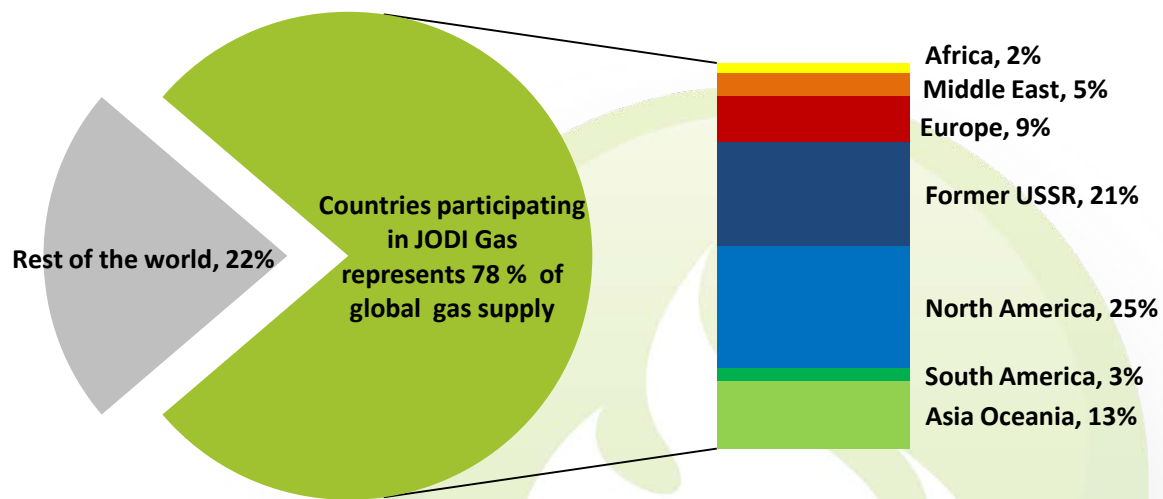
Qatar and Kuwait started submitting JODI-Gas data raising number of countries participating in JODI-Gas to 69, representing 80% of Global natural gas supply and demand.

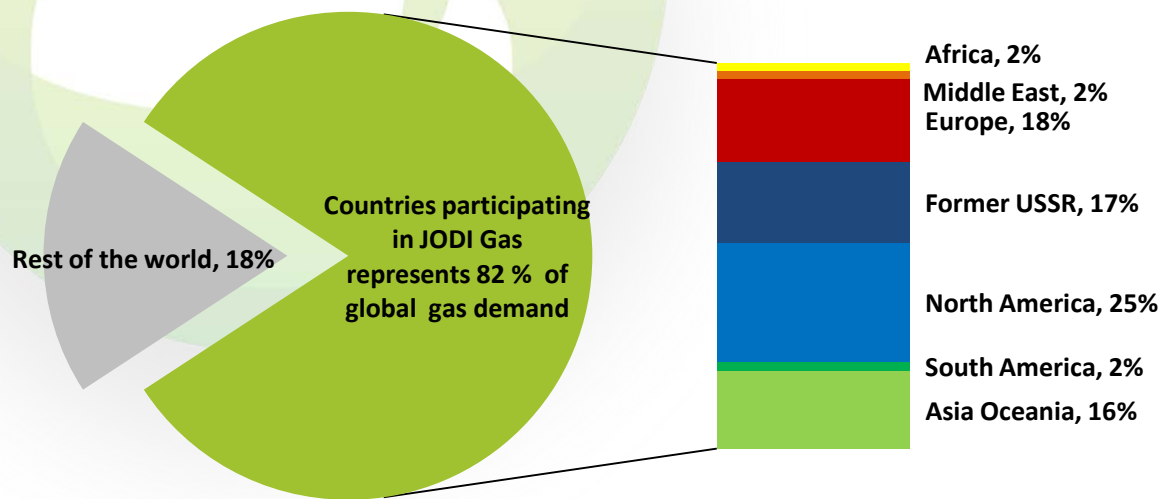
