## IEA/OECD – Gas JODI data collection


- Gas JODI an exercise since October 2009
- Member countries were asked to volunteer in providing M-1 data on natural gas
- About half of the countries were reporting
- A reminder was sent in June 2010
- Since then, there is some increase in the number of countries submitting.

Total OECD - 30 countries


29 Gas consuming countries

- Current JODI gas data collection is an exercise.
- Testing the capability of countries to send monthly gas data. No obligation.
- Currently data is not processed at IEA due to lack of resources.
- Action has been taken and a possible increase in resources is expected from next year.
  - Depending on the outcome and decisions of Inter Secretariat Jodi working group, a proposal could be made to the member countries to make it a permanent exercise.
